

Johnson City Public Library Study Room Policy

Johnson City Public Library study rooms allow access to quiet areas for individual or small group work. To ensure the rooms are available to all members of the community, patrons using the study rooms are required to comply with the following:

- Use of individual study rooms are on a first come, first served basis.
- The Campbell Study Room may be reserved.
- Users of the Campbell Study Room must sign in at the Information Desk.
- To allow fair access to the study rooms, a 2-hour time limit may be applied to room use if others are waiting.
- Study rooms may not be used for commercial purposes (transactional activities prohibited).
- Users must abide by the Library Code of Conduct.

The library reserves the right to deny or restrict access to any individual who does not follow this or any other library policies.
