JCPL's First Scholastic Book Fair!

Children participating in the Summer Reading Program this year were rewarded for their hard work with Book Bucks they could redeem at JCPL's first ever Scholastic Book Fair! Scholastic Book Fair nostalgia was in the air as many parents who attended Scholastic Book Fairs when they were in grade school excitedly introduced their children to this special experience. Scholastic has coined the term Bookjoy to describe "that head-to-toe thrill that comes from choosing your own book, holding a brand new adventure in your hands and losing yourself in a story." Bookjoy was definitely reflected in the faces of the children participating in the Book Fair! The Friends of the Library sponsored the Scholastic Book Fair by contributing \$4,400 to fund the Book Bucks earned by the children in the Summer Reading Program. The children redeemed their Book Bucks to purchase books and other reading related puzzles and games at the Book Fair. In addition to the Book Bucks, parents invested additional funds for a total of \$8,329 in sales during the four days of the Book Fair. Scholastic provides for JCPL to use a portion of the proceeds to be applied to purchases from Scholastic of books to be used in the children's library.

A Retirement Tribute: Cathy Griffith

After 32 years serving our community, Cathy Griffith will be retiring from her position as Assistant Director of Johnson City Public Library. Julia Turpin, Library Director, commented on Cathy's career, "Cathy has been a consistent and steady leader at JCPL for 32 years and in two buildings! Cathy gave her all to her work and always kept the Library's success as the focus of sometimes tough decisions. We are a better organization thanks to Cathy."



Cathy's job titles over the years, starting out as "Secretary/Bookkeeper," becoming "Office Manager," then "Business Manager," followed by "Assistant Director," with a brief stint as "Interim Director," reflect her willingness to consistently step up to meet and fill the evolving demands and needs of our increasingly complex library organization. Cathy had a front row seat supporting JCPL's adoption of monumental new technologies in libraries, including the transition from a card catalog to the first Integrated Library System (ILS), and implementation of RFID. The move to the world class building we enjoy today was only the distance of a few blocks, but it set the stage to enable JCPL to succeed and thrive, serving and growing with our community into the 21st century. "CHANGE was the word," Cathy explains, "that spanned two centuries." The accomplishment Cathy is the most proud of is the many years of excellent audits our Library, as a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit corporation, has achieved. Cathy says, "I may be one of the few people who really enjoys being audited!" Cathy's role in ensuring the financial integrity of JCPL could best be described as CFO of a Non-Profit Corporation. "The financial health of an organization is critical to its success," Cathy explains, "and helping to keep JCPL financially sound is a role I have enjoyed and taken very seriously." What Cathy has most enjoyed about her library service "is the fact that no two days are the same and there is never a dull moment." She is grateful for the stellar staff she has worked with who are devoted to providing the best possible library service for everyone.
